



CY1384 KIDDIES SUPER SOFT CHUNKY TODDLER BOBBLE STITCH HOODY

Materials and Measurements

6mm crochet hook

Pattern Notes -

UK terminology used

The chain 1 does not count as a stitch, always work into the 1st stitch of the row.

The increases are made by working 3 half treble crochet into the same stitch.

Bobble stitch – worked on the wrong side of the work – [yarn over, insert, yarn over, pull up a loop, yarn over, pull through 2 loops] 4 times, yarn over, pull through all 5 loops

24 to 36 months -

4 balls of Midnight 2114 - yarn A

1 ball of Powder 2145 - yarn B

12 to 18 months -

3 balls of Petal 2385 - yarn A

1 ball of Lemondrop 2126 - yarn B

24 to 36 months -

With varn A ch 48

Row 1 - into 2nd ch htc, htc 6, inc, htc 7, inc, htc 15, inc, htc 7, inc, htc 7	(47)
Row 2 - ch 1, t, htc 8, inc, htc 9, inc, htc 17, inc, hdc 9, inc, htc 8	
Row 3 - ch 1, t, htc 9, inc, htc 11, inc, htc 19, inc, htc 11, inc, htc 9	
Row 4 - ch 1, t, htc 10, inc, htc 13, inc, htc 21, inc, htc 13, inc, htc 10	
Row 5 - ch 1, t, htc 11, inc, htc 15, inc, htc 23, inc, htc 15, inc, htc 11	
Row 6 - ch 1, t, htc 12, inc, htc 17, inc, htc 25, inc, htc 17, inc, htc 12	
Row 7 - ch 1, t, htc 13, inc, htc 19, inc, htc 27, inc, htc 19, inc, htc 13	
Row 8 – ch 1, t, htc 14, inc, htc 21, inc, htc 29, inc, htc 21, inc, htc, 14	
Separating for sleeves –	

Row 9 - ch 1, t, htc 16, ch 1, sk 23, htc 33, ch 1, sk 23, htc 16

Row 10 – ch 1, t, htc across the 16 htc + 1 ch + 33 htc + 1 ch + 16 htc	(67)		
Body –			
Row 11 - ch 1, t, htc across, fo A			
Row 12 – attach yarn B, ch 1, dc into 1st st, * bb into nxt, dc into nxt, rept from * across, fo B	(33 bb sts)		
Row 13 – attach yarn A, ch 1, htc into every dc and bb st across	(67)		
Rows 14 and 15 – ch 1, t, htc across, fo A			
Rept rows 12 to 15 – 4 more times, fo			
Sleeves –			
With A attach under arm			
Row 1 - ch 1, htc around till you have worked 24 sts , slst to 1st htc	(24)		
Rows 2 to 15, ch 1, t, htc around, slst to 1st htc, fo A			
Row 16 – attach B, ch 1, t, working on wrong side, * dc in 1st st, bb into nxt, rept from * around, fo B			
Row 17 – attach A, ch 1, t, working on the right side, htc into every dc and bb, rept around, slst to 1st htc			
Rows 18 and 19 – ch 1, t, htc around, slst to 1st htc			
Fasten off and repeat for other sleeve			
Hood –			
With right side facing, attach A at top left corner on row 1 –			
Row 1 – working across the neckline, ch 1, htc across until you have worked 47 sts			
Rows 2 till 17 – ch 1, t, htc across	(47)		
Line up edges with the wrong side facing outwards.			
Going through both loops on both sides, loosely slst both edges together, fo			
Trim –			
Attach A at bottom left corner			
Row 1 – ch 1, work 1 htc into the end of every row, htc around the hood, htc down the right side	Э		
Row 2 – ch 1, t, htc around, fo			

Sew on your 3 buttons at this point (left for girls or right for boys) at approximately rows 4, 8 and 12

To make the button loops -

Attach A at bottom corner and working around the edge, place 1 dc into every htc till you reach the place where your button loops should fall (rows 4, 8 and 12 on the opposite side of where your buttons are)

* Ch 4 and dc into nxt 3 sts *, 1 button loop made, rept from * to * twice more, dc to bottom placing 3 dc into last st, dc into every st across the bottom ending with 2 dc into the 1st st, slst to 1st dc

Fasten off and weave in all ends.

12 to 18 months -

With yarn A ch 42	
Row 1 - into 2nd ch htc, htc 5, inc, htc 6, inc, htc 13, inc, htc 6, inc, htc 6	(41)
Row 2 - ch 1, t, htc 7, inc, htc 8, inc, htc 15, inc, htc 8, inc, htc 7	
Row 3 - ch 1, t, htc 8, inc, htc 10, inc, htc 17, inc, htc 10, inc, htc 8	
Row 4 - ch 1, t, htc 9, inc, htc 12, inc, htc 19, inc, htc 12, inc, htc 9	
Row 5 - ch 1, t, htc 10, inc, htc 14, inc, htc 21, inc, htc 14, inc, htc 10	
Row 6 - ch 1, t, htc 11, inc, htc 16, inc, htc 23, inc, htc 16, inc, htc 11	
Row 7 - ch 1, t, htc 12, inc, htc 18, inc, htc 25, inc, htc 18, inc, htc 12	
Row 8 – ch 1, t, htc 14, ch 1, sk 20, htc 29, ch 1, sk 20, htc 14	
Row 9 – ch 1, t, htc across the 14 htc + 1 ch + 29 htc + 1 ch + htc 14	(59)
Body –	
Row 10 - ch 1, t, htc across, fo A	
Row 11 – attach yarn B at opposite end, ch 1, dc into 1st st, * bb into nxt, dc into nxt, rept from B	* across, fo (29 bb sts)
Rows 12 – attach yarn A, ch 1, htc into every dc and bb st across	(59)
Rows 13 and 14 – ch 1, t, htc across, fo A	
Rept rows 11 to 14 – 3 more times, fo	
Sleeves –	
With A attach under arm	
Row 1 - ch 1, htc around till you have worked 20 sts , slst to 1st htc	(20)
Rows 2 to 10 - ch 1, t, htc around, slst to 1st htc, fo A	
Row 11 – attach B, ch 1, t, working on wrong side, * dc in 1st st, bb into nxt, rept from * around	, fo B
Row 13 – attach A, ch 1, t, working on the right side, htc into every dc and bb, rept around, slst	to 1st htc
Row 14 – ch 1, htc around, slst to 1st htc	
Fasten off and repeat for other sleeve	
Hood –	
With right side facing, attach A at top left corner on row 1 –	
Row 1 – working across the neckline, ch 1, htc across until you have worked 41 sts	
Rows 2 till 13– ch 1, t, htc across	(41)
Line up edges with the wrong side facing outwards.	
Going through both loops on both sides, loosely slst both edges together, fo	

Trim –

Attach A at bottom left corner

Row 1 - ch 1, work 1 htc into the end of every row, htc around the hood, htc down the right side

Row 2 - ch 1, t, htc around, fo

Sew on your 3 buttons at this point (left for girls or right for boys) at approximately rows 2, 6 and 10

To make the button loops -

Attach A at bottom corner and working around the edge, place 1 dc into every htc till you reach the place where your button loops should fall (rows 2, 6 and 10 on the opposite side of where your buttons are)

* Ch 4 and dc into nxt 3 sts *, 1 button loop made, rept from * to * twice more, dc to bottom placing 3 dc into last st, dc into every st across the bottom ending with 2 dc into the 1st st, slst to 1st dc

Fasten off and weave in all ends.
