T-SHIRT TOPPER CARDIGAN  
NEWBORN AND 3 MONTHS  
CY1403

**Materials**

4 mm crochet hook

3 x 15 mm wooden buttons

1 ball Anti-pilling pure baby DK

Examples used are - lemon 2131 and lilac 2113

**Pattern Notes –**

UK terminology used

Gauge – 10 rows, and 16 htr on the yoke to 10 cm (4")

The chain one does not count as a stitch, always work into the 1st stitch unless otherwise stated.

Shell – dc + htr + tr + dbtr all worked into the same stitch or space.

**Abbreviations -**

dbtr – treble  
crochet

tr – treble crochet

htr – half treble  
crochet

dc – double  
crochet

sh(s) – shell(s)

Inc - 3 half treble  
crochet into nxt  
chain or space

ch(s) – chain(s)

st(s) – stitches

rept - repeat

slst – slip stitch

sk – skip

fo – fasten off

**Newborn –**

Ch 42

Row 1 - into 2nd ch htr, htr 5, inc, htr 6, inc, htr 13, inc, htr 6, inc, htr 6

Row 2 - ch 1, t, htr 7, inc, htr 8, inc, htr 15, inc, htr 8, inc, htr 7

Row 3 - ch 1, t, htr 8, inc, htr 10, inc, htr 17, inc, htr 10, inc, htr 8

Row 4 - ch 1, t, htr 9, inc, htr 12, inc, htr 19, inc, htr 12, inc, htr 9

Row 5 - ch 1, t, htr 10, inc, htr 14, inc, htr 21, inc, htr 14, inc, htr 10

Row 6 - ch 1, t, htr 11, inc, htr 16, inc, htr 23, inc, htr 16, inc, htr 11

Row 7 - ch 1, t, htr 12, inc, htr 18, inc, htr 25, inc, htr 18, inc, htr 12

**Separating for sleeves –**

Row 8 – ch 1, t, htr 14, ch 1, sk 20, htr 29, ch 1, sk 20, htr 14

Row 9 – ch 1, t, htr across the 14 htr + 1 ch + 29 htr + 1 ch + htr 14 (59)

**Body –**

Row 10 – ch 1, t, sh into 1<sup>st</sup> st, \* sk 2, sh into nxt, rept from \* across ending with a dc into last (19 shs)

Row 11 – ch 1, t, \* sh into dc, rept from \* across ending with a dc into last tr

Rows 12 to 22– rept row 11

**Button band –**

Attach at bottom left corner

Row 1 – ch 1, dc evenly to the top

Row 2 – ch 1, t, dc to bottom

Row 3 – ch 1, t, dc to top, fo leaving enough yarn to sew on your buttons

### **Buttonhole band –**

Attach bottom right corner

Row 1 – ch 1, dc evenly to the top

Row 2 – ch 1, t, dc 2 , \* ch 2, sk 2, dc 3 \* , rept \* to \* , ch 2 sk 2, dc to bottom

Row 3 – ch 1, t, dc into each dc, and 2 dc into every ch 2 sp, fo

### **Sleeve trim –**

Attach under arm

Row 1 – ch 1, htr 22 sts around the edge, slst to 1<sup>st</sup> htr

Row 2 – ch 1, sh into 1<sup>st</sup>, \* sk 2, sh into nxt \* , rept from \* to \* 5 more times , slst to dc of 1<sup>st</sup> sh, fo

Whip stitch closed the small gap under the arms and sew on buttons.

Weave in all ends

### **3 months -**

Ch 48

Row 1 - into 2nd ch htr, htr 6, inc, htr 7, inc, htr 15, inc, htr 7, inc, htr 7

Row 2 - ch 1, t, htr 8, inc, htr 9, inc, htr 17, inc, htr 9, inc, htr 8

Row 3 - ch 1, t, htr 9, inc, htr 11, inc, htr 19, inc, htr 11, inc, htr 9

Row 4 - ch 1, t, htr 10, inc, htr 13, inc, htr 21, inc, htr 13, inc, htr 10

Row 5 - ch 1, t, htr 11, inc, htr 15, inc, htr 23, inc, htr 15, inc, htr 11

Row 6 - ch 1, t, htr 12, inc, htr 17, inc, htr 25, inc, htr 17, inc, htr 12

Row 7 - ch 1, t, htr 13, inc, htr 19, inc, htr 27, inc, htr 19, inc, htr 13

Row 8 – ch 1, t, htr 14, inc, htr 21, inc, htr 29, inc, htr 21, inc, htr, 14

### **Separating for sleeves –**

Row 9 – ch 1, t, htr 16, ch 1, sk 23, htr 33, ch 1, sk 23, htr 16

Row 10 – ch 1, t, htr across the 16 htr + 1 ch + 33 htr + 1 ch + 16 htr (67)

### **Body –**

Row 11 – ch 1, t, sh into 1<sup>st</sup> st, \* sk 2, sh into nxt, rept from \* across ending with a dc into last (22 shs)

Row 12 – ch 1, t, \* sh into dc, rept from \* across ending with a dc into last tr

Rows 13 to 24 – rept row 12

### **Button band –**

Attach at bottom left corner

Row 1 – ch 1, dc evenly to the top

Row 2 – ch 1, t, dc to bottom

Row 3 – ch 1, t, dc to top, fo leaving enough yarn to sew on your buttons

### **Buttonhole band –**

Attach bottom right corner

Row 1 – ch 1, dc evenly to the top

Row 2 – ch 1, t, dc 2, \* ch 2, sk 2, dc 3 \*, rept \* to \*, ch 2 sk 2, dc to bottom

Row 3 – ch 1, t, dc into each dc, and 2 dc into every ch 2 sp, fo

### **Sleeve trim –**

Attach under arm

Row 1 – ch 1, htr 24 sts around the edge, slst to 1<sup>st</sup> htr

Row 2 – ch 1, sh into 1<sup>st</sup>, \* sk 2, sh into nxt \*, rept from \* to \* 6 more times, slst to dc of 1<sup>st</sup> sh, fo

Whip stitch closed the small gap under the arms and sew on buttons.

Weave in all ends
