

KIDDIES KALEIDOSCOPE CY1459 ZIG ZAG FILET BLANKET

Materials -

- 2 x 100g balls of Cygnet Kiddies Kaleidoscope in Vanilla Mint 279 yarn A
- 1 x ball of Pato Everyday DK in saxe 991 Yarn B
- 4.5mm Crochet Hook

Darning Needle

Pattern Notes -

US Terminology used

The numbers at the end of the rounds in brackets, are the amount of stitches/pattern repeats you should have at the end of that row.

The chain 1 does not count as a stitch. Always work into the 1st stitch of the row unless otherwise stated.

Abbreviations explained -

Dc in dc – work 1 double crochet into the next double crochet only

Dc in chsp – work 1 double crochet into the chain 1 space from the row below

Dc 6 (7)(8) – 1 double crochet into the nxt 6 (7) (8) double crochet stitches and so on

Ch 1 / sk 1 - chain 1, skip 1 double crochet

Ps – puff stitch – [yarn over, insert hook into stitch, yarn over pull up a loop], 3 times into the same stitch, chain 1 to close

Abbreviations –ps(s) – puff stitch(s)ch(s) - chain(s)t - turn your workchsp- chain spacenxt – nextdc - double crochetrept - repeathdc – half double crochetsk – skip

cor – corner slst – slip stitch fo – fasten off sp(s) - space(s)

With yarn A Chain - 90

Row 1 – dc in 2nd ch from hook, dc in every ch across

(89)

Row 2 - ch 1, t, dc 2, * ch 1, sk 1, dc 11 *, rept * to * 6 more times, ch 1, sk, dc 2

Row 3 - ch 1, t, dc 2, dc in chsp, ch 1 sk 1, dc 9, * ch 1 sk 1, dc in chsp, ch 1 sk 1, dc 9 * rept * to * to

Row 4 - ch 1, t, dc 3, dc in chsp, * ch 1 sk 1, dc 7, ch 1 sk 1, dc in chsp, dc in dc, dc in chsp *, rept * to * 5 more times, ch 1 sk 1, dc 7, ch 1 sk 1, dc in chsp, dc 3

Row 5 - ch 1, t, dc 4, dc in chsp, ch 1 sk 1, * dc 5, ch 1 sk 1, dc in chsp, dc 3, dc in chsp, ch 1 sk 1 *, rept * dc 5 more times, dc 5, dc 1 sk 1, dc 1 in chsp, dc 4

Row 6 – ch 1, t, dc 5, dc in chsp, *ch 1 sk 1, dc 3, ch 1 sk 1,dc in chsp, dc 5, dc in chsp * rept * to * 5 more times, ch 1 sk 1, dc 3, ch 1 sk 1, dc in chsp, dc 5

Row 7 – ch 1, t, dc 6, dc in chsp, * ch 1 sk 1, dc in dc, ch 1 sk 1, dc in chsp, dc 7, dc in chsp *, rept * to * 5 more times, ch 1 sk 1, dc in dc, ch 1 sk 1, dc in chsp, dc 6

Row 8 – ch 1, t, dc 2, * ch 1 sk 1, dc 4, dc in chsp, ch 1 sk 1, dc in chsp, dc 4, * rept * to * 5 more times, ch 1 sk 1, dc 4, dc in chsp, ch 1 sk 1, dc in chsp, dc 4, ch 1 sk 1, dc 2

Row 9 – ch 1, t, dc 2, * dc in chsp, ch 1 sk 1, dc 4, dc in chsp, dc 4, ch 1 sk 1 *, rept * to * 5 more times, dc in chsp, ch 1 sk 1, dc 4, dc in chsp, dc 4, ch 1 sk 1, dc in chsp, dc 2

Rept rows to 4 to 9 - 7 more times

Rept rows 4 to 7 1 more time

Finishing rows -

Row 1 - Ch 1, t, dc 7, * dc in chsp, ch 1 sk 1, dc in chsp, dc 9 *, rept * to * 5 more times, dc in chsp, ch 1 sk 1, dc in chsp, dc 7

Row 2 – ch 1, t, dc 8, * dc in chsp, dc 11 * Rept * to * 5 more times, dc in chsp, dc 8, fo yarn A

Border -

Row 1 of the border will be worked into the spaces between the stitches along the top and bottom.

When working the sides work into the space between the last 2 sts of every row.

Depending on the row you are working you will need to work over either the dc or the dc and the turning ch.

Corners will be made by working 3 hdc + ch 1 + 3 hdc.

With the right side facing you, attach B into the space between the 1st 2 dc of the row you just worked

Row 1 – ch 1, * 3 hdc + ch 1 + 3 hdc into 1st sp, hdc into every sp across till you have 1 left, into last sp, 3 hdc + ch 1 + 3 hdc, working down the side work 2 hdc into the end of every row *, rept from * to * once more slst to 1st hdc

Row 2 – slst into cor ch 1 sp, ch 1, * into ch 1 sp work 3 hdc, hdc into every st across, 3 hdc into cor ch 1 sp, hdc into every st down the side, rept from * around, slst to 1st hdc

Row 3 - slst into the 2nd hdc of the cor 3, ch 1, * into st work 3 ps's (cor made), sk 1, ps into nxt st, rept along the top, rept from * around by working 3 ps's into the 2nd hdc of the 3 from the row before, sk 1 and ps into nxt st along the sides and bottom, slst to 1st ps

Row 4 – slst into the sp between the 1st and 2nd ps's, ch 1, * into 1st sp work 2 hdc, ch 2, 2 hdc into nxt sp (cor made) working along the top work 2 hdc into every ch 1 sp bet the ps's, until you reach the cor, rept from * all the way around, slst to 1st hdc

Row 5 – slst into ch 2 cor sp, * in sp work 2 hdc + ch 2 + 2 hdc, hdc into every st till you reach the corner, rept from * around, slst to 1st hdc

Fasten off, weave in all ends.



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
